

Thank you for taking the time to review this page. Since you are here, you will want to ask yourself these questions:

Do you think there will be problems in Heaven? The answer is No ... because there won't be any sin there. Do you think you have any sin? If you have sin, will you be there in Heaven?

Romans 3:23 says, "For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God." The Bible supplies rules for which to live ... the 10 commandments as found in Exodus 20. Take this test for yourself by asking: in the last month have you murdered anyone ... have you committed adultery ... have you lied ... have you used the Lord's name in vain ... have you stolen anything ... do you covet what others have????? If you answered no to all of these ... good for you. Now: do you honor your parents ... do you keep the Sabbath Holy?? If you answered yes to these ... good for you again.

Finally, the last two test questions: in the last month has anyone or anything been more important to you than God? 1 Corinthians 13:4-8 reads; "Love is patient, love is kind. It does not envy, it does not boast, it is not proud. It is not rude, it is not self-seeking, it is not easily angered, it keeps no record of wrongs. Love does not delight in evil but rejoices with the truth. It always protects, always trusts, always hopes, always perseveres. Love never fails." Now read it and substitute your name for "love" and "it". Is this true about you? Certainly not all of it. But, God IS Love so you can substitute God's name for "love" and "it" and easily ADMIT that man is sinful.

It seems easier to BELIEVE that the human body in all its intricacies is not merely an accident ... it must have been on purpose and thus there must be a Creator. If so, do you BELIEVE that Jesus died on the cross to pay for your sin? **John 3:16** says, "For God so loved the world that He gave His one and only Son, that whosoever BELIEVES in Him shall not perish but have eternal life."

What is the most important thing in YOUR life? There are many that want God IN their lives, but not OVER their lives. Perhaps you believe IN God. Well, even the demons believe in God ... and shudder ... according to James 2:19. Does satan 'Believe' in God? Yes, he does. So why isn't satan saved? Because satan will not COMMIT (or SUBMIT) to God. **Exodus 20:3** says, "You shall have no other gods before Me." It is important to understand that being a Christian is to become a new creation ... giving your heart and complete control of your life over to God.

So ... ADMIT - BELIEVE - COMMIT. Are YOU willing to SUBMIT to God? If so, you simply need to ask Jesus into your heart. The words aren't critical, just that you pray through the A, B, C's that have been covered. Here's an example: "Father God, I ADMIT that I have sinned against You and that I need Your forgiveness. I BELIEVE that You sent Your Son, Jesus, to die on the cross to pay for my sin. Please forgive my sin. I COMMIT myself to You and I submit myself to Your complete authority over my life. In the name of Jesus, I pray."

If you prayed this prayer and meant what you just prayed, then congratulations! You have been adopted by God into His family. It is a tremendously exciting event both here and in Heaven and it has consequences that will ring for ETERNITY. It's a VERY big deal.
